



## **THE CROWN AT SPROXTON**

**The Crown at Sproxton is over 140 years old. When it was restored by the current owner, the stone external walls were insulated and in keeping with owner Barry Spencer's Architectural Salvage business many old architectural features were reused. The stone lintels to the courtyard windows, for example, were from a Regency House in Bourne, ornate rails an orphanage in Scunthorpe, window to the bedroom corridor from Clipsham Hall and fireplace in the bar from an old house in Edinburgh.**
